

Registration and Acceptance of Risk

Participation Statement

It is recognised that Mountain biking/BMX is an activity with a danger of personal injury or death.

Under 18s

Riders who are under 18 years old require a parent or legal guardian to complete the registration and acceptance of risk for them. Parents or guardians should be aware of and accept these risks and accept responsibility for the minors' actions and involvement. Adult supervision requirements are down to the judgement of the child's parent/guardian. Your child's safety and wellbeing is the sole responsibility of you, their parent/guardian and NOT of Burlish Bike Park or Open Trail staff/management.

All participants

Your safety is YOUR responsibility

- ❖ Burlish Bike Park is like a skatepark/pumptrack, in that it is a sports facility with no supervision.
- ❖ Burlish Bike Park is NOT like a swimming pool, do NOT expect a lifeguard on duty!
- ❖ Do NOT expect supervision on site
- ❖ Do NOT expect first aiders on site
